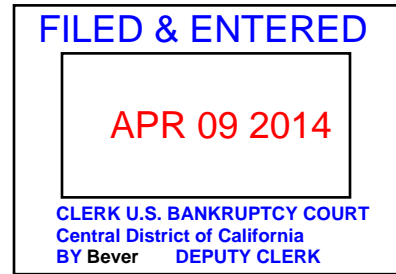

**ORDER GRANTING MOTION OF THE
CHAPTER 7 TRUSTEE FOR ORDER
AUTHORIZING THE EXAMINATIONS OF
IDENTIFIED MEDIA VENDORS PURSUANT
TO FED. R. BANKR. P. 2004**

[No Hearing Required]

20 On April 8, 2014, David K. Gottlieb, in his capacity as the Chapter 7 Trustee (the "Trustee"),
21 filed the *Notice of Motion and Motion of the Chapter 7 Trustee For Order Authorizing the*
22 *Examinations of Identified Media Vendors Pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2004* (the "Motion"). The
23 Court has considered the Motion, the accompanying Memorandum of Points and Authorities, the
24 Declaration of Paul Huygens in support of the Motion, and the exhibit thereto. Based on its review
25 and consideration, the Court finds that (i) notice of the Motion was adequate and appropriate, and no
26 further or other notice need be given; (ii) the authority requested by the Trustee to issue subpoenas
27 identified in the Motion is appropriate; and (iii) good cause exists to grant the Motion.

1 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

2 1. The Motion is GRANTED in its entirety;

3 2. The Trustee is authorized, pursuant to sections 105(a) and 1106(a)(3) of title 11 of the
4 United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"), Rules 2004 and 9016 of the Federal Rules of
5 Bankruptcy Procedure (the "Bankruptcy Rules"), and Local Bankruptcy Rule 2004-1, to issue and
6 serve such subpoenas as may be necessary to compel the production of documents identified in the
7 Motion from the Subject Media Vendors;¹

8 3. The Trustee shall serve each Rule 2004 Subpoena and a copy of the order entered
9 pursuant to the Motion on (i) the Subject Media Vendors (i.e., the witness to whom the Rule 2004
10 Subpoena is directed), and (ii) the United States Trustee for the Central District of California;

11 4. The Trustee shall file with the Court an affidavit or declaration of service for each
12 Rule 2004 Subpoena or notices of Rule 2004 Subpoenas that are served;

13 5. Witnesses on whom a Rule 2004 Subpoena for production are served are directed to
14 produce all responsive documents when compliance is due subject to any documents withheld under
15 a claim of privilege;

16 6. If a witness withholds production of any documents to the Trustee based upon a claim
17 of privilege, such witness is directed to provide counsel for the Trustee with a privilege log
18 containing the information required under Bankruptcy Rule 7026(a)(5) no later than the date
19 production is due (unless otherwise agreed by the Trustee);

20 7. In the event of any discovery dispute in relation hereto, counsel shall first meet and
21 confer in an effort to resolve the dispute in accordance with Local Bankruptcy Rule 7026-1(c).

22 8. This order is without prejudice to the Trustee's right to file further motions seeking
23 additional documents and testimony pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 2004(a) or any other applicable
24 Bankruptcy Rules; and
